## Services Provided

### General Health Check-ups

Free consultations and physical examinations for adults and children.

### Blood Pressure & Sugar Tests

Screening for hypertension and diabetes — critical for rural communities.

### Medicine Distribution

Essential medicines provided free of charge to those in need.

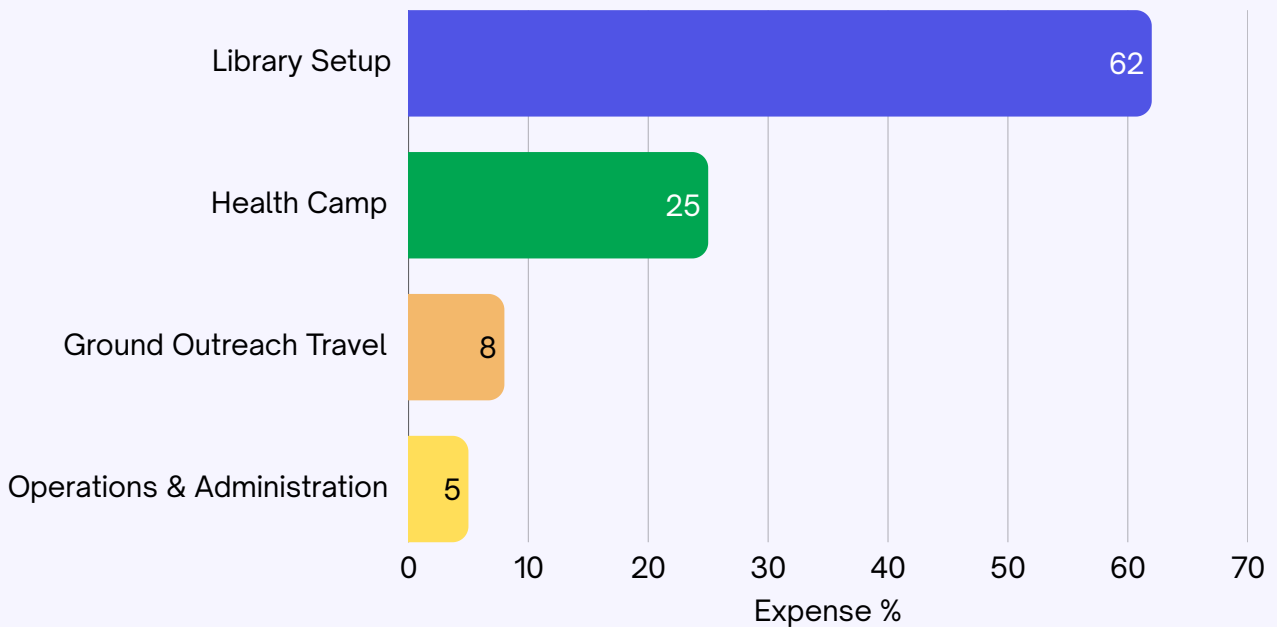

### A Note on Year 1 Finances

Our first year was heavily founder-funded, reflecting our commitment to act rather than wait. Detailed financial records are maintained internally and available upon request. A formal external audit will be published from Year 2 onwards.

# Challenges & Learnings

Our first year taught us more than any plan could have. We share these challenges not as shortcomings, but as proof that we showed up and kept going.

## Challenges We Faced

Honest reflection makes us stronger. Here is what we learned on the ground in Year 1.

### Reaching Remote Schools

Identifying and accessing government schools in remote areas of UP and Bihar required significant groundwork, local coordination, and multiple visits.

### Building Community Trust

Trust is earned, not assumed. Early months required consistent presence before communities opened their doors to our programs.

### Logistics & Resources

Transporting books, library materials, and medical supplies to distributed locations was both cost-intensive and time-consuming.

## Key Learnings

- Local partnerships make the difference
- Start small, build deep community roots first
- Consistency matters more than scale in Year 1

# Road Ahead

## Our Vision for 2026–27

The foundation is laid. The communities trust us. The children are waiting. Now we build higher with more libraries, more workshops, more lives touched, and more states reached. The best of **Shail-Satya Foundation (SSF)** is still ahead.

## 25 Libraries - Scaling Dosti Kitabon Se

Phase 2 targets 25 libraries in government schools across UP, Bihar, and beyond giving thousands more children their first dedicated reading space.

## Know Your Constitution Workshops

Taking civic awareness inside classrooms — structured workshops in government schools on Fundamental Rights, Duties, and constitutional values.

## State Expansion

Moving beyond UP and Bihar — identifying new states where our library and health camp model can be replicated with local community partnerships.

## Volunteer Programme

Launching a structured volunteer onboarding system — giving individuals, students, and corporates a clear way to contribute time and skills on the ground and over the social media.

## Formal Financial Audit

Commissioning our first external financial audit — published as part of Annual Report 2026–27 for full donor transparency.
